EDUCATION LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

MAY 30, 2019, 2019

There is continued debate about the "school takeover" legislation (SB70). There are several proposals, including HB 154, SB 110, and HB 166 provisions. A group has convened to somehow synthesize these and other ideas. Lehner said the document was little more than notes from a working group of a dozen thought leaders on education. (See separate file) Discussion about high school graduation and testing (as a whole) continues to heat up. There are some higher education issues (mostly aimed at public institutions, as of now) including performance audits, college graduation requirements and general core, and freedom of expression. Day on the Square was small but made an impact with many of the legislators. There is still the problem of omitting "non-profit" from the rules related to teacher preparation that popped up in the budget bill.

Regarding the adoption of health education standards. --1st Hearing-Sponsor

STUDENT ASSESSMENTS (MANNING, G., CRAWLEY, E.)

To reduce the number of end-of-course assessments required for high school graduation and to require each school district to form a work group to evaluate the amount of time students spend on testing. **--1st Hearing-Sponsor**

RELIGIOUS EXPRESSION (GINTER, T.)

Regarding student religious expression and to entitle the act the "Ohio Student Religious Liberties Act of 2019." --3rd Hearing-All testimony

HB 90

EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS (ANTANI, N.)

To require the development of an instructional program and educational and informational materials and the dissemination of those materials to protect the humanity of the unborn child and to make an appropriation. **CONTINUED-AMENDED** (No testimony) The panel accepted an <u>amendment</u> changing the implementation timeline for the instructional program. With the change, schools would have one full calendar year for implementation after the start of



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the school year

following the program's approval by the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review.

PERFORMANCE AUDITS (MCCOLLEY, R., RULLI, M.)

To authorize the Auditor of State to conduct performance audits of any and all state institutions of higher education.
