

## Ohio Association of Colleges for Teacher Education

After passing Congressional maps and taking a week off, the legislature is back this week with a light schedule. Few of the bills we're watching are getting hearings. There will be a first hearing in a Senate committee on a bill (HB218) that broadly expands exemptions to vaccine mandates. HB218, which passed the House on a party-line vote just before Thanksgiving, would effectively make vaccine requirements meaningless, allowing anyone to claim an objection of conscience to receiving even an FDA-approved vaccine. The bill would also prevent private businesses like bars and concert venues from requiring proof of vaccination for entry.

One new bill, **HB 497**, is designed to amend sections 3301.0711, 3301.163, and 3313.608 of the Revised Code to eliminate retention under the Third Grade Reading Guarantee. Other bills worth watching include: **HB 99** (**Armed School Staff**: To expressly exempt persons authorized to go armed within a school safety zone from a requirement that peace officer basic training be obtained and to require that those persons successfully complete firearms training that meets or exceeds the training requirements for concealed handgun licensees for the exemption to apply. Am. 109.78 and 2923.122), **SB 267** (**Aggravated Bullying**: To require a tiered disciplinary procedure for and student instruction on preventing harassment, intimidation, or bullying in school and to create the offense of aggravated bullying as a third-degree misdemeanor),

There is very little time left in this legislative session and I am watching the committee schedule carefully. The Lame Duck session is always interesting.
