## LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

March 1, 2022

This has been a very confused, busy, and tense time in the Ohio House and Senate. Redistricting remains a major issue for the Commission. With the involvement of the Ohio Supreme Court, redistricting is a “hot button” issue. Also on the agenda: gun issues, reproductive rights issues, freedom of speech issues, and, of course, CRT!

#### Ohio House Bill 582

##### Status

Spectrum: Partisan Bill (Republican 3-0)

Status: Introduced on February 28 2022 - 25% progression

Action: 2022-02-28 - Introduced

##### Summary

To amend sections 3302.11, 3311.053, 3311.73, 3313.09, 3501.01, 3505.03, 3505.04, 3513.04, 3513.052, and 3513.261 and to repeal sections 3513.254, 3513.255, and 3513.256 of the Revised Code regarding the nomination and election of members of school district boards of education.
